

Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal

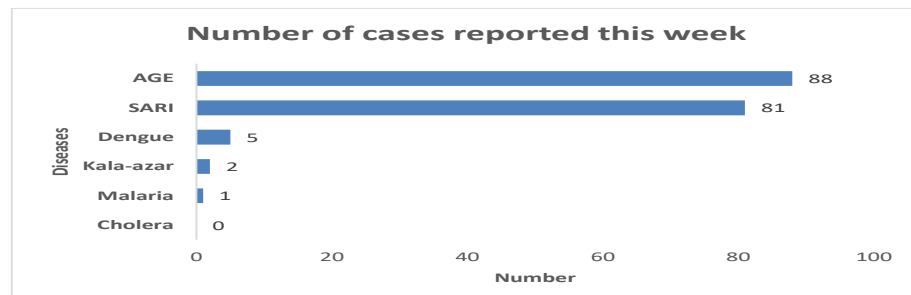
28th Epidemiological Week

25th July, 2021

Highlights

- 680556 Cases of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) have been confirmed in Nepal, of which 643615 cases have been recovered so far.
- Of the reported cases, Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE) is the leading cause of morbidity in week 28.

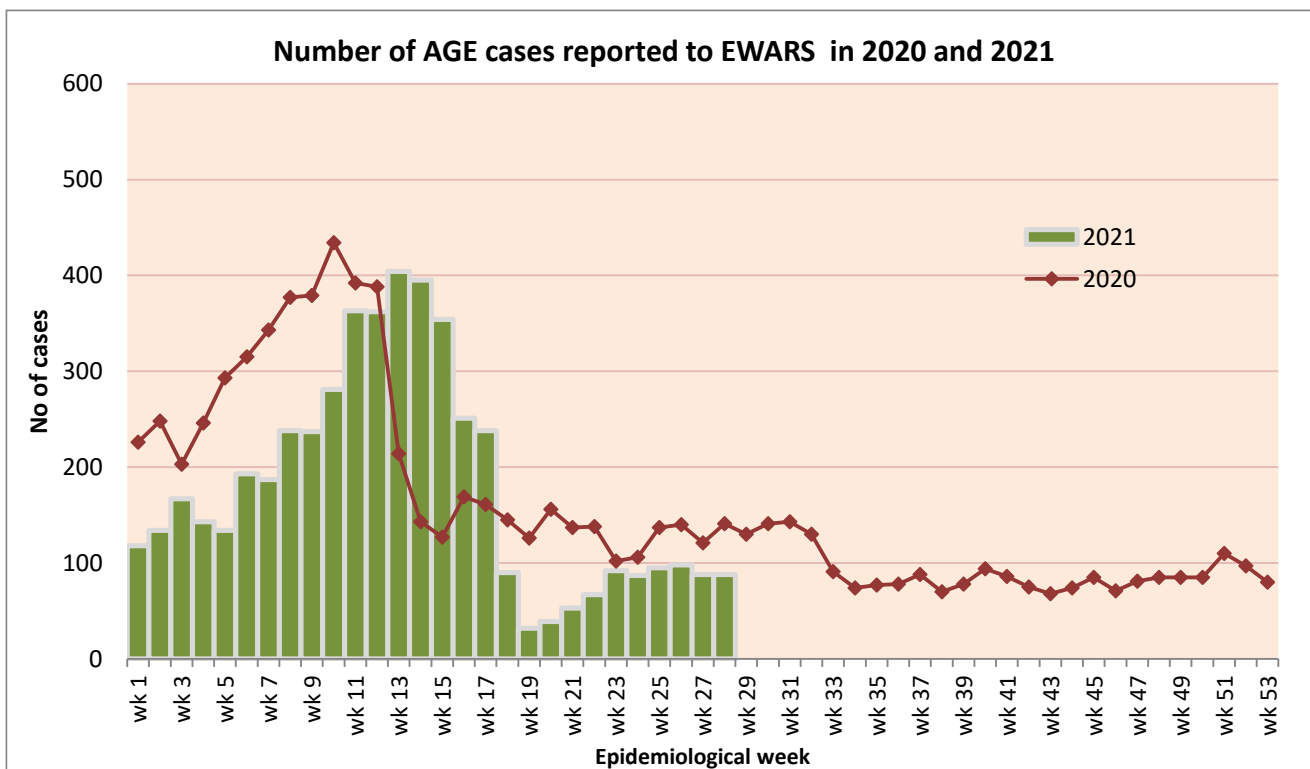
Number of cases reported for each disease this week



Note: This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.

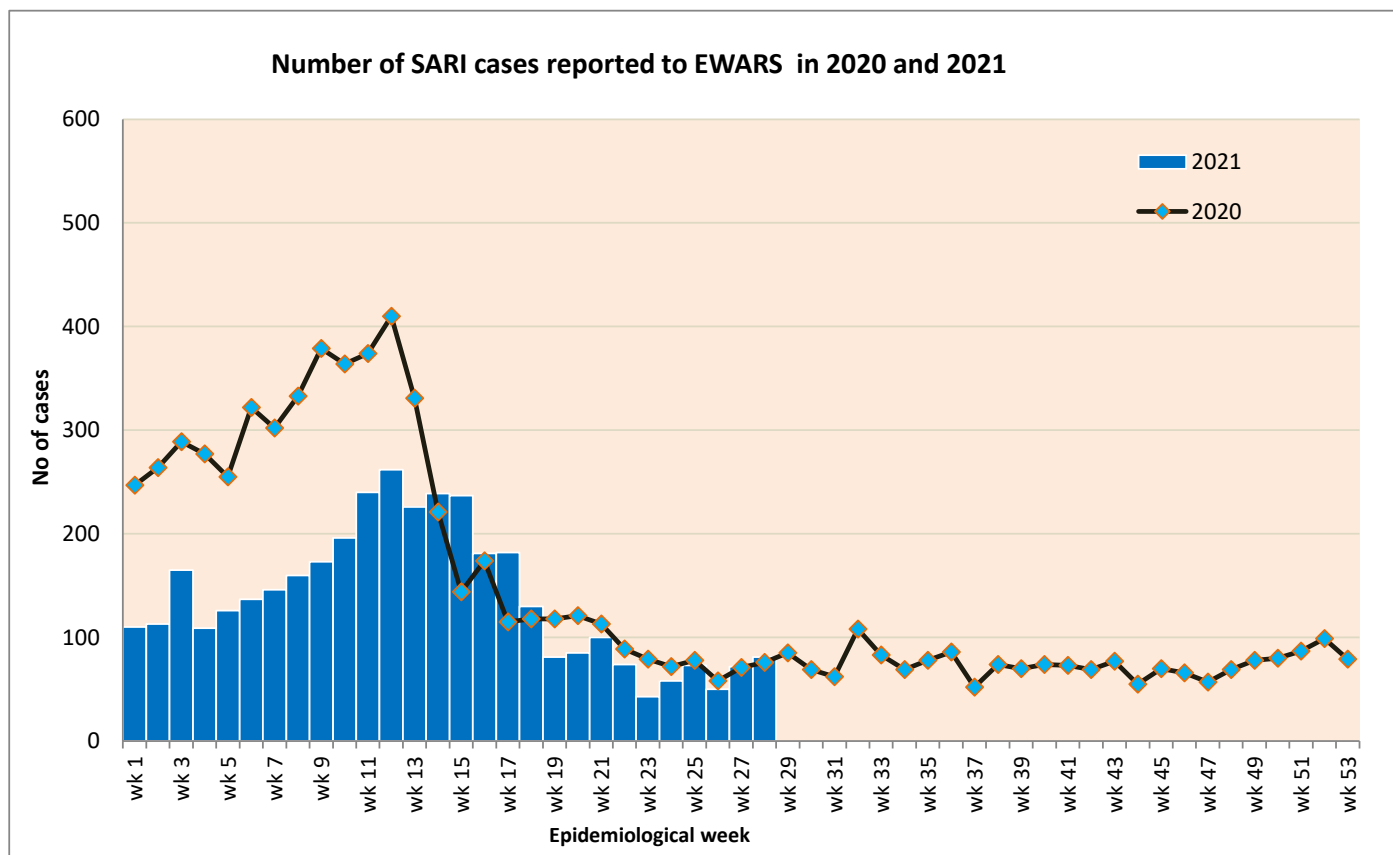
1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE) and Cholera

- 88 cases of AGE are reported this week. Majority of these cases are from Bajhang (8 cases), Jumla (7 Cases), Rukum West, Kathmandu, Khotang, and Jhapa (6 Cases from each districts).
- 141 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2020.



2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 81 cases of SARI are reported this week. Majority of these cases are from Morang (9 cases), Ilam and Saptari (8 cases from each district), Jhapa (6 cases).
- 76 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2020.



3. Malaria

- One case of malaria was reported this week and which was reported from Achham district.
- Four case of malaria were reported this week in 2020.

4. Dengue

- Five case of dengue was reported this week. The majority of the case were reported from Sankhuwasabha (2 Case), Myagdi, Nawalparasi East and Sindhupalchok (1 cases from each district).
- Five cases of dengue were reported this week in 2020.

5. Kala-azar

- Two case of kala-azar were reported this week and one each cases were reported from Sankhuwasabha and Gulmi district.
- Four cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2020.

Other diseases

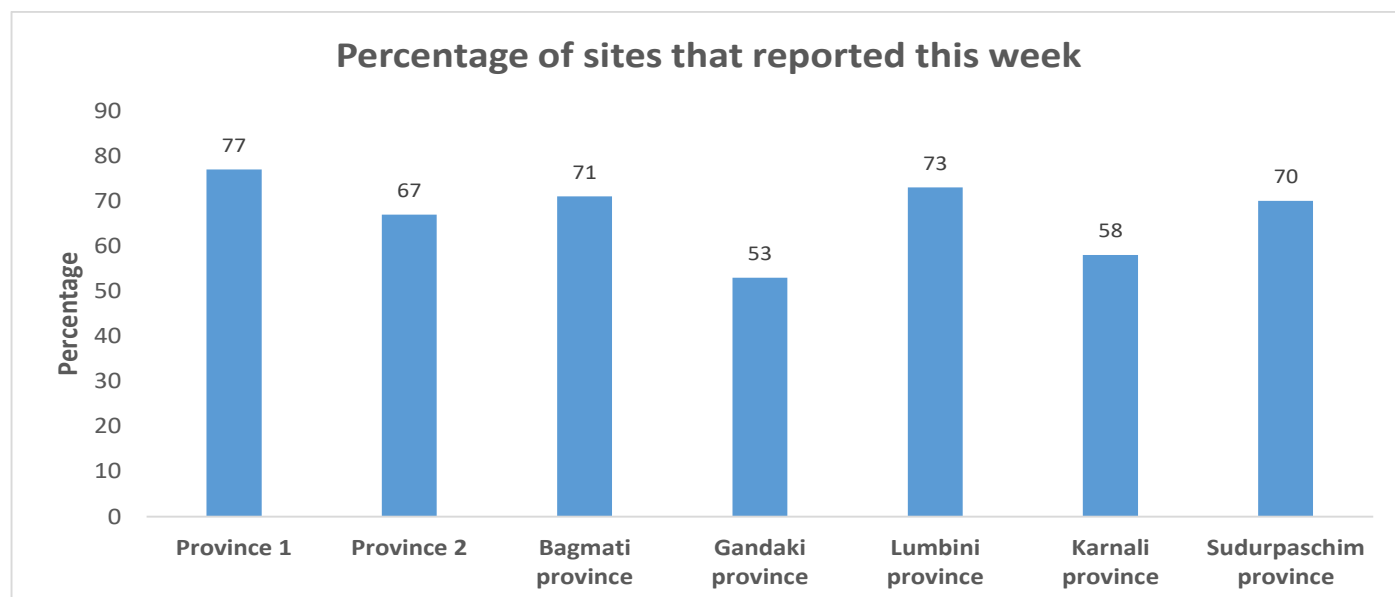
Scrub typhus

- 20 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. The majority of the cases were reported from Kailali (3 cases), Bardiya, Kanchanpur and Arghakhanchi (2 cases from each district).
- 24 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2020.
