Weekly Bulletin

(36th Epidemiological Week)

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This bulletin includes the updates from the Early Warning Reporting System (EWARS). It includes data since January 2015 till date, including comparison of same period during last year.

Section 1: The Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)

Highlights

- 144 Cholera cases are confirmed by NPHL so far since 30 June, 25 cases in Kathmandu, 110 cases in Lalitpur, 1 in Bhaktapur, 1 in Dhading and 7 from unidentified place.
- A total of 275 cases of Scrub typhus including 8 deaths have been reported from 37 different districts.
- 74 cases of AGE from Jamuni Madhepura VDC-2 of Saptari district are reported from DPHO, Saptari since 13 September, 2016. A health team is mobilized from DPHO and periphery level for the response. No death has been reported.
- Three cases of Malaria (*Plasmodium Vivax*) are reported this week, one from District Hospital, Pyuthan and two from Mahakali Zonal Hospital, Kanchanpur and the cases are from the same district.
- One case of Dengue is reported this week from Sukraraj Tropical and Infectious Disease Hospital, Teku and the case is from Dhading district.
- Five cases of Kala-azar are reported this week, three from Sukraraj Tropical and Infectious Disease Hospital, Teku and one each from Koshi Zonal hospital, Morang and District Hospital, Siraha. The cases are from Pyuthan, Arghakhanchi, Doti, Morang and Siraha district respectively.


The EWARS was established in 1997 to strengthen the flow of information on vector-borne and other outbreak prone infectious diseases from the district to Epidemiology and Disease Control Division (EDCD) and Vector-Borne Disease Research and Training Center (VBDRTC), Hetauda. Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) can be mobilized at short notice to facilitate prompt outbreak response at Central, Regional and District level. They can also support local level health institutions for investigation and outbreak control activities.

This information system is hospital-based and is currently operational in 60 hospitals (out of 81 sites) throughout Nepal (Figure 1). So far, the EWARS mainly focuses on the **weekly reporting** of number of cases and deaths (including "zero" reports) of six priority diseases/syndromes—Malaria, Kala-azar, Dengue, Acute Gastroenteritis (AGE), Cholera and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI), and other epidemic potential diseases/syndromes (like enteric fever). It equally focuses on **immediate reporting** (to be reported within 24 hours of diagnosis) of one confirmed case of Cholera, Kala-azar severe and complicated Malaria and one suspect/clinical case of Dengue as well as 5 or more cases of AGE and SARI from the same geographical locality in one week period.



Reporting Status


Out of 60 functional EWARS sentinel sites, report was received from 43 sentinel sites (72 percent) whereas 17 sentinel sites did not report in 36th Epidemiological week. The reporting coverage is decreased as compared to the previous week.



1.1 Acute Gastro-Enteritis and Cholera

206 cases of AGE are reported in 36th epidemiological week of 2016. Among 206 cases, the majority of cases are from Dhading (19 cases), Kathmandu (16 cases), Dolakha (14 cases), Kanchanpur (10 cases), Dhanusha (10 cases), Morang (9 cases), Mustang (8 cases), Nawalparasi (8 cases) and Syangja (8 cases) district. The number of AGE cases reported in 36th week this year did not exceed the number of AGE cases reported in the same week last year (278 cases).


No death from AGE is reported this week. Eight deaths from AGE are reported so far this year.




Cholera: 144 Cholera (*Vibrio cholerae* **Ogawa 01**) cases were confirmed by NPHLso far since 30 June, 25 cases in Kathmandu, 110 cases in Lalitpur, one case in Bhaktapur, One in Dhading and 7 from unidentified place. Epidemiological and environmental investigations along with water and sanitation activities are carried out in coordination with DPHO and partners.

1.2 Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

289 cases of SARI are reported in 36th epidemiological week of 2016. The cases of SARI reported this week exceed the number reported in the same week last year (154 cases). Among 289 cases, the majority of cases are from, Jhapa (35 cases), Lalitpur (20 cases), Morang (20 cases), Palpa (18 cases), Kathmandu (17 cases), Bhojpur (11 cases) and Dhading (11 cases) district.





1.3 Enteric Fever

165 cases of Enteric fever are reported this week. The majority of cases are from Syangja (17 cases), Nawalparasi (14 cases), Ramechhap (13 cases), Palpa (11 cases), Sindhuli (11 cases), Kaski (11 cases) and Gulmi (9 cases) district. The cases of Enteric fever is high since last few weeks so it is important to remain alert to detect potential clusters and conduct investigation to identify potential common source of contamination.

1.4 Malaria

Three cases of Malaria (*Plasmodium Vivax*) are reported this week, one from District Hospital, Pyuthan and two from Mahakali Zonal Hospital, Kanchanpur and the cases are from Pyuthan Municipality of Pyuthan district and Mahendranagar Municipality of Kanchanpur district.

Fourty six cases of Malaria are reported so far this year. Ninety cases of Malaria were reported through EWARS in 2015.

1.5 Dengue

One case of Dengue is reported this week from Sukraraj Tropical and Infectious Disease Hospital, Teku and the case is from Dhading district. Only seven case of Dengue is reported so far this year. Fifty-eight cases of Dengue were reported through EWARS in 2015

1.6 Kala-azar

Five cases of Kala-azar are reported this week, three from Sukraraj Tropical and Infectious Disease Hospital, Teku and one each from Koshi Zonal hospital, Morang and District Hospital, Siraha. The cases are from Pyuth an, Arghakhanchi, Doti, Morang and Siraha district respectively.
