


# 1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 76 cases of AGE were reported this week. The majority of these cases were reported from Lalitpur (8 cases), Kathmandu and Khotang (6 cases from each districts), Okhaldhung (5 cases), Siraha (4 cases).
- 167 Cases of AGE were reported this week in 2021.



# 2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

143 Cases of SARI were reported this week. The majority of these cases were reported from Jhapa (14 cases), Surkhet (13 cases), Pyuthan and Morang (10 cases from each cases), Bhajhang and Lalitpur (8 cases from each districts), Kailali (7 cases).



• 165 Cases of SARI were reported this week in 2021.

#### 3. Malaria

- Zero case of malaria was reported this week.

#### 4. Dengue

- Two cases of dengue were reported this week; one each cases were reported from Kanchanpur and Bhajhang districts.
- Zero cases of dengue were reported this week in 2021.

## 5. Kala-azar

- Six cases of kala-azar were reported this week. The majority of the cases were reported from Surkhet (3 cases) and one each cases were reported from Dadeldhura, Palpa and Jajarkot districts.
- Four case of kala-azar were reported this week in 2021.

#### 6. Cholera

- Zero cases of Cholera were reported this week.
- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week in 2021.


# Other diseases Scrub typhus

- 13 Cases of scrub typhus were reported this week. The majority of the cases were reported from Darchula (6 cases), Palpa (2 cases), and one each cases were reported from Rolpa, Kapilbastu, Kailali, Baglung and Rupndehi districts.
- Six cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2021.
