This bulletin includes the updates from the Early Warning Reporting System (EWARS). It includes data since January 2015 till date, including comparison of same period during last year.


Section 1: The Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)

Highlights

- **Dengue**: A total of 1527 Dengue cases including one death(on 15th November, 2016) have been reported from 30 different districts since January 2016 out of which 687 cases from Chitwan and 405 cases from Jhapa district.
- Scrub Typhus: A total of 831 cases of Scrub Typhus cases including 14 deaths have been reported from 47 different districts of Nepal Since July, 2016. Out of which 535 cases are from Chitwan District and 194 from Kailali district.
- Kala-azar: No case of Kala-azar is reported this week.
- Malaria: No case of malaria is reported this week.
- No death from AGE and SARI is reported this week.


The EWARS was established in 1997 to strengthen the flow of information on vector-borne and other outbreak prone infectious diseases from the district to Epidemiology and Disease Control Division (EDCD) and Vector-Borne Disease Research and Training Center (VBDRTC), Hetauda. Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) can be mobilized at short notice to facilitate prompt outbreak response at Central, Regional and District level. They can also support local level health institutions for investigation and outbreak control activities.

This information system is hospital-based and is currently operational in 60 hospitals (out of 81 sites) throughout Nepal (Figure 1). So far, the EWARS mainly focuses on the **weekly reporting** of number of cases and deaths (including "zero" reports) of six priority diseases/syndromes—Malaria, Kala-azar, Dengue, Acute Gastroenteritis (AGE), Cholera and Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI), and other epidemic potential diseases/syndromes (like enteric fever). It equally focuses on **immediate reporting** (to be reported within 24 hours of diagnosis) of one confirmed case of Cholera, Kala-azar severe and complicated Malaria and one suspect/clinical case of Dengue as well as 5 or more cases of AGE and SARI from the same geographical locality in one week period.



Reporting Status


Out of 60 functional EWARS sentinel sites, report was received from 37 sentinel sites (62 percent) whereas 23 sentinel sites did not report in 51st Epidemiological week. The reporting coverage is same as compared to the previous week.



1.1 Acute Gastro-Enteritis and Cholera

132 cases of AGE are reported in 51st epidemiological week of 2016. Among 132 cases, the majority of cases are from Morang (18 cases), Kathmandu (13 cases), Jhapa (10 cases), Dhanusha (9 cases), Kaski (9 cases), Lamjung (8 cases), Mahottari (6 cases) and Makawanpur (6 cases) district. The number of AGE cases reported in 51st week this year slightly exceeds the number of AGE cases reported in the same week last year (112 cases).


No death from AGE is reported this week. Thirteen deaths from AGE are reported so far this year.




• Cholera: A total 169 cholera cases were confirmed by the National Public Health Laboratory so far since 30 June, 31 cases in Kathmandu, 119 cases in Lalitpur, 1 in Bhaktapur, 1 in Kavre, 6 in Dhading, 3 in Saptari and 8 from unidentified place.

1.2 Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

104 cases of SARI are reported in 51st epidemiological week of 2016. The cases of SARI reported this week did not exceed the number reported in the same week last year (302 cases). Among 104 cases, the majority of cases are from, Jhapa (22 cases), Mahottari (22 cases), Sunsari (9 cases), Palpa (6 cases), Bardiya (4 cases), Kanchanpur (4 cases), Ilam (3 cases) and Dhankuta (3 cases) districts.





1.3 Enteric Fever

13 cases of Enteric fever are reported this week, including 4 from Lamjung and 2 from Jhapa, 2 from Saptari and one each from Chitwan, Gulmi, Morang, Sindhupalchok and Tanahu. The number of enteric fever reported this week is less than the last week and is in decreasing trend.

1.4 Malaria

No case of malaria is reported this week. Eighty three cases of Malaria are reported so far this year. Ninety cases of Malaria were reported through EWARS in 2015.

1.5 Dengue

A total of 1527 Dengue cases including one death have been reported from 30 different districts out of which 687 cases from Chitwan and 405 cases from Jhapa, 164 from Rupandehi, 82 from Makawanpur, 37 from Banke, 25 from Bardiya, 22 from Surkhet, 14 from Kailali, 9 from Morang, 8 from Dang, 28 from Sarlahi, 7 from Parsa, 3 from Nawalparasi, 4 from Dhading, 3 from Kapilvastu, 4 from Bara, 5 from Kathmandu, 2 from Kanchanpur, 3 from Mahottari, 4 from Sunsari, 2 from Kavre one each from Lalitpur, Saptari, Kaski, Syangja, Baglung, Kalikot, Rukum, Sunsari, Pyuthan and Baitadi.

1.6 Kala-azar

No case of Kala-azar is reported this week. 150 cases of Kala-azar are reported so far this year.
