
# Early Warning and Reporting System (EWARS)- Weekly Bulletin: Nepal 6<sup>th</sup> Epidemiological Week, 2022 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2022

**Note:** This bulletin includes data since January 2021 till date, including comparison of the same period last year. Since, May 2019, 36 new sentinel sites (including public hospitals, private hospitals, and medical colleges) were added and were gradually oriented and started reporting, thus increasing the number of reporting sites. The current number of sentinel sites is 118.


## 1. Acute Gastro-Enteritis (AGE)

- 45 cases of AGE were reported this week. The majority of these cases were reported Sunsari (5 cases), Khotang and Morang (4 cases from each districts), Mahottari and Rupandehi (3 cases from each districts).
- 193 cases of AGE were reported this week in 2021.



## 2. Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI)

- 89 cases of SARI were reported this week. The majority of these cases were reported from Rupandehi (13 cases), Morang and Dang (8 cases from each districts), Nawalparasi West (6 cases), Pyuthan (5 cases), Jhapa and Kapilbastu (4 cases from each districts).
- 137 cases of SARI were reported this week in 2021.

### 3. Malaria

- Zero case of malaria was reported this week.
- Zero cases of malaria was reported this week in 2021.

#### 4. Dengue

- Zero cases of dengue was reported this week.
- Four cases of dengue were reported this week in 2021.

#### 5. Kala-azar

- Two cases of kala-azar were reported this week; one each cases was reported from Palpa and Khotang districts.
- Five cases of kala-azar were reported this week in 2021.

#### 6. Cholera

- Zero cases of Cholera were reported this week.
- Zero case of Cholera was reported this week in 2021.


## Other diseases Scrub typhus

- Four cases of scrub typhus were reported this week; two each cases were reported from Palpa and Arghakhanchi districts.
- 10 cases of scrub typhus were reported this week in 2021.
